Predictive validity: Caregivers of individuals with dementia (Cooper, Katona, & Livingston, 2008): Adequate predictive validity over a 2 year testing period for changes in caregiver burden.Change in caregiver burden score was related to changes in the use of problem-focused (r = 0.33) and dysfunctional (r= 0.32) coping strategies, but not the use of emotion-focused coping.

Attachment theory is a psychological, evolutionary and ethological theory concerning relationships between humans. The most important tenet is that young children need to develop a relationship with at least one primary caregiver for normal social and emotional development. The theory was formulated by psychiatrist and psychoanalyst John Bowlby.

Schore, the top attachment scholar known as the "American Bowlby," cited the 2009 study of 10,000 adult AAs using three attachment categories which showed that from 1999 to 2009, secure attachment fell by 17.1%. [3] Using four attachment categories, if 55% were secure in 1999, then after a 17% drop, only 46% were secure in 2009.
