For eight or more editors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and the last editor's name.

When a work is part of a greater whole (e.g., a journal article or edited book chapter), the title of the article or chapter appears in the title element of the reference and the title of the greater whole (the journal or edited book) appears in the source element. When the title of the work cannot be determined, treat the work as having no title.

author, date, title, and source. Those components are organized as follows: Author. (Date). Title. Source. If you are unable to locate components for a reference, the APA Style website has a page on Missing Reference Information. There are two format patterns: italic title and italic ...

rest of the paper, reference entries should be double spaced. Use one space after the punctuation within each reference (e.g., after the period that follows the date). See APA 7, Section 16.1.
