2-3 days until you no longer see the bubbling.

remove all the mushy or dead roots, and spray the whole plant with Hydrogen peroxide 3%. Let airdry for a moment, and then wipe off any excess water left behind. Repot the orchid in a clean pot using fresh media. Make sure not to pot the orchid too deep in the media, as we want the crown to stay dry.
