Start the Power Pivot add-in for Excel - Excel

Create Relationships Between Tables with Power Pivot Excel. Now that you have a Data Model, it's time to create relationships between each of the data tables. Select Power Pivot, then select Manage Data Model to open the Power Pivot Window. Select Home, then select Diagram View .

When the Power Pivot add-on is enabled, the Power Pivot tab in the ribbon is available, as shown in the following image. From the Power Pivot ribbon tab, select Manage from the Data Model section. When you select Manage , the Power Pivot window appears, which is where you can view and manage the data model, add calculations, establish relationships, and see elements of your Power Pivot data model .

Click File > Options > Add Ins. Select COM Add-Ins from the Manage list, and click Go. Check the box for Microsoft Power Pivot for Excel and click Ok. The Power Pivot tab will then be visible on the Ribbon. If you are using Excel 2010 you will need to download the Power Pivot Add-In from the Microsoft Site.

If the Power Pivot tab does not appear in the Ribbon, close Excel and restart. After installing the add-in, you should see the Power Pivot tab on the Excel Ribbon, as shown.
