Inclusive Teaching Strategies. Inclusive teaching refers to pedagogy that strives to serve the needs of all students, regardless of background or identity, and support their engagement with subject material. Hearing diverse perspectives can enrich student learning by exposing everyone to stimulating discussion, expanding approaches to traditional and contemporary issues, and situating learning within students' own contexts while exploring those contexts.

One of the most important teaching strategies in inclusive classroom settings that you can use involves letting each student share an "island of competency" with the rest of the class. For example, if a student struggles academically but enjoys music, the student should be encouraged to make up or sing "review songs" to help the rest of the class study.
